Margam Country Park is pleased to be organising a
Community Christmas Tree Festival for 2020.



This special event aims to bring Park groups, community groups, schools, businesses, visitors ... together making a beautiful festive display for all to enjoy. The festival will be staged in Margam Castle and will be open to visitors to enjoy from Saturday 14th November through to Sunday 29th November. Visitor Entry to the festival will be by donation.



You can get involved by entering a tree into the festival.
You will need to provide a decorated tree.

Your tree can reflect you, your organisation or could be your interpretation of Christmas. It is really up to you how you do it, whether it has a colour theme, hand-made decorations or something completely different! All are welcome!



- Key Information:
- Trees should be artificial (to save watering and to protect the floor!).
- The floor space provided for each tree is 6 ft wide and 4 ft deep.
- Smaller Trees are very welcome, please provide your own small table if needed.
- The trees can be in the form of handmade sculptures - so get creative!
- Power in the Castle is very limited so any lights will need to be battery operated.
- Please provide a name tag for your tree for visitors to read and find out who made it.
- The event will have stewards onsite, and the trees will be locked in the building overnight however they will be left at your own risk.

- The trees will need to be brought to the castle and set up on Thursday 12th or Friday 13th November - between 9.30am and 4.00pm
- Trees will need to be collected at the end of the festival on Monday 30th November between 9.30am and 4.00pm.
- Entering a tree is FREE however you can make a donation which will go towards the festival organisation costs with any excess going to helping manage the Park.
