We take our environmental responsibility seriously...

A restored turbine can now produce approximately 25KW of renewable energy which is used to power buildings on the Park. The hydro-electric scheme creates no emissions while in service and any unused energy is fed back to the National Grid.

We ask that visitors do their bit to help keep the park clean by not dropping litter and sorting their rubbish accordingly. We have recycling bins, dog poop bins and standard litter bins in the Park but help us by taking your litter home.



Explore ...

Margam Park Train

Enjoy a leisurely ride on our very own narrow gauge railway. The route takes you through the wonderful historic landscape, taking in views of the farm trail, castle, lakes, woodlands and wildlife. The train operates seasonally, please check the times prior to your visit. Tickets can be purchased from the Park entry cabin and at the gift shop

Fishing

Furzemill Lake offers a tranquil retreat for coarse fishing. The lake has a variety of fish including large specimens of carp and tench. Daily and annual permits are available from the entrance cabin during opening times; a rod licence is required.

BBQ Area

A covered BBQ area is available for exclusive hire, ideal for family, friends and organised groups. To check availability please contact the Park Office on 01639 881635.

Wood Vibrations Trail

Visitors can find harmony in nature with a musical woodland trail. The trail was created with the help of local school children and meanders past a series of giant musical instruments. Take the path from the Turbine House to the Farm Trail.
